'Did not our hearts burn within us as He talked to us on the road and explained the scriptures to us?' (Luke 24:32)

In St Luke's Gospel today we listen to the familiar account of the two disciples' encounter with Jesus on the road to Emmaus. The disciples discerned a burning in their hearts after their encounter with the Risen Lord and, in the true spirit of Jesus' mission, went to spread the Good News to others.

We ask the Risen Lord today to open our eyes and hearts to the Scriptures and, through them, to reveal Himself to us. We ask also that our hunger for the Eucharist will be such that we may always recognise its centrality to all that we believe as Catholics and to an ever-growing relationship with Jesus.
