I hope you had a good and relaxing Christmas. Thank you to all who helped celebrate our Christmas liturgies in the Cathedral, Cortoon & Lavally. It was encouraging to see so many people in attendance. I wish you a happy and healthy New Year.

On New Year's Day, Archbishop Francis will launch the Jubilee Year of Hope for the Archdiocese of Tuam at the Midday Mass in the Cathedral.

Pope Francis opened the Holy Door in St. Peter’s on Christmas Eve., marking the start of the Jubilee Year. This Door remains sealed between the Jubilees, which occur every twenty-five years.

In his homily, Pope Francis said: "Brothers and sisters, with the opening of the Holy Door, we have inaugurated a new Jubilee, and each of us can enter into the mystery of this extraordinary event. Tonight, the Door of hope has opened wide to the world."

In the Old Testament, a Jubilee takes place every fifty years. The Jubilee lasted the whole year and was an opportunity for God's people to review their activities and relationships in the light of God's call.

Today, in the Catholic Church, we celebrate a jubilee year every twenty-five years. The year is a time of reconciliation with God and receiving his favour and blessing.

The Holy Year is an invitation to reassess our lives and activities in the light of Jesus' calling and to redirect them in more fruitful ways.

The Jubilee will continue until the Feast of the Epiphany on January 6th, 2026.
